- Riding on Rebak Island's spectacular trails will take you 90 minutes
- There is rainforest vegetation, komodo lizards, otters, birdlife, and more.

- Visiting Telaga Keriang, a water wheel abandoned in the 1970s
- Ride along the ocean's edge on a hillside
- A ride past Malaysia's first free-flow crystal factory in 1998
- Take a ride on a wooden bridge over a swampy coastal area
- Ride across the rocky trails to explore the former Rebak Jetty
- The ride takes you through thick bush and over open grassland
- View the hardstand deck from the hill
- This ride offers a fantastic view of Senari Bay as you ride along the coastline.

WHAT TO BRING

- Enclosed, sturdy Shoes
- You may want to bring a towel if you plan to swim

⚠️ WHILE ON TOUR

Rules & Regulations

ATV riding can be dangerous so you should not:

- Ride or race at speeds considered dangerous to myself or others (including shortcuts). The speed limit on the road is 12 km/hour, and the speed limit of the road is 10 km/hour
- Vary, deter or change course from the lead tour guide riding line and trail given and demonstrated by the tour guide
- If you suffer from back or neck pain or a heart condition, or if you suffer from any other pre-existing condition.
- Consume alcohol or drugs before driving
- Riding without a helmet
- The ATVs were not kept at a safe distance, an estimate of two ATVs - approximately three meters apart.
- Stands on the ATV while it is in motion
- Did not follow the instructor's order signs, such as slowing down and controlling the brakes
- Steer without using both hands.
- Do not respect other individuals in the facility or conduct themselves in a respectful manner.
- Weight up to 80KG for a single rider and 150KG for a couple

THE ATV TOUR

Into the horizon, you ride, saddle up as you open the throttle. The ride takes 90 minutes, including a stop on the beachfront for photos and a quick swim for maximum 20 minutes. An additional 15 minutes are dedicated to helmet fitting and safety briefing, as well as 15 minutes for transition between experiences.

The trails consist of a combination of dirt trails, which take you uphill and downhill.

You will also ride along 1km of golden sand long beaches overlooking Langkawi Island, the coastline of the cape, over rocky terrain, and to the edge of the ocean. With the unpredictable scenery of the island, each trail will provide non-stop fun for you.

The ride will take you to the main part of the island where it was discovered by Tok Musang.

Here's where it all begins.

Tok Musang, the island's founder, inhabited the island in 1970 with his family and farm animals. During his exploration of the shoreline, he discovered a freshwater source and named it Telaga Keriang.

As such, he made this the front or entrance to Rebak Island. The wheel is located right next to the Rebak Tree, which gives the island its name.

Your journey will also take you past a crystal factory that operated between 1998 and 2001.

The factory was originally built to manufacture handmade crystal glass blowings. Due to high skills requirements and the economic downturn, the factory could not sustain its production costs and shut down.

MINIMUM AGE

The rider must be at least 15 years old, and the passenger must be at least 3 years old.
